

# After Party Cleaning List

## Same Day Cleaning Tasks

- Package up any leftovers and put them in the fridge, or give them to your guests as they leave. This will prevent ants or spoiled food odors from taking over your house while you sleep.
- Using a dishpan as a carrier, collect all the empty bottles, cans, plastic cups from the premises and throw them into recycling bin.
- Gather all the large trash in the bags and put them away for pick-up.
- Collect dirty tableware to fill the dishwasher and run the load. Soak remaining dishes.
- Check for spills on furniture, rugs or the carpet and begin treating for stains if needed.
- If you were using table linens, run a load of laundry with them. Include the used bathrooms and kitchen towels in the load.

## Next Day After Party Cleanup

- If you ran a load of laundry last night, put it in the dryer.
- Empty the dishwasher and put in the dishes that you left to soak last night.
- Hand-wash pieces that were too large or too fragile for the dishwasher.
- Clean the stove and microwave. Wipe kitchen countertops and cabinet handles.
- Pour toilet bowl cleaner into the toilets in the bathrooms. Spray disinfectant on the toilet seat, handle, and the sink faucet. Let it sit while you complete other tasks.
- Take down decorations. Store any items you'll be keeping and get rid of the rest.
- Go back to the bathroom. Finish cleaning the toilets and counters. Clean fingerprints of mirrors.
- Remove the load of laundry from the dryer. Fold and put those items away.
- Clean the floors. Vacuum and wipe clean where needed.
- Replace rugs and any items you may have moved for the party.
- If guests were outdoors, rearrange your patio furniture to its regular setup.
- Clean grill and outdoor kitchen if used in the party.
- Hose down the patio to get rid of dirt or sticky messes.
